THURSDAYS ONLY**

Please know, you **MUST** have called to have your mask package ready for pick up. If you do not call to order masks, **you cannot receive a mask package.**

**WALK-INS ARE NOT ALLOWED**

Masks should be placed and sealed in a paper bag after use and can be stored in the bag for reuse. Please remember **ALWAYS** to wash your hands for 20 seconds after removing your masks.

If you are homebound and are in need of a mask, please call the Stoneham Board of Health at **781-279-2621** and leave your name, address and telephone number. We will call you back to arrange a mask drop off. **PLEASE note that we are providing mask packets only to those who have not received masks during the mask distribution on 5/9. We ask that there is ONLY ONE mask package per household address.**
