WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PLAN. The Metro North Regional Employment Board has developed its Fiscal Year 2012 (7/1/11 - 6/30/12) Workforce Development Plan. The REB charters two career centers to provide labor exchange services funded by the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) and in its role as the WIA fiscal agent, subcontracts with area providers to provide youth programs and education and occupational skills training through individual training accounts (ITAs) for unemployed residents of the following cities and towns: Arlington, Belmont, Burlington, Cambridge, Chelsea, Everett, Malden, Medford, Melrose, North Reading, Reading, Revere, Somerville, Stoneham, Wakefield, Watertown, Wilmington, Winchester, Winthrop, and Woburn. An Executive Summary of the plan will be available on June 21, 2011 for review and comment by community-based organizations, local education agencies, other public agencies, labor organizations, and the general public. Comments should be submitted in writing before July 21, 2011.
