I live nowhere near the Weiss Farm property, but having been a resident these many many years, I can certainly tell you the proposed use now before the town will be a disaster waiting to happen.

Franklin is at it's narrowest and most curving point exactly where the proposed development is being considered. Houses are minimally set back from the street. so widening is impossible without immanent domain takeovers.

The increase in traffic will effect every surrounding neighborhood in Stoneham up to Main & Franklin as well as Main and William, then well into Melrose up to their Main Street (where as you know Franklin Elementary School sits).

This is absolutely the worst possible place to build high impact housing.
