WATER FACILITIES
 Water works constructed 1883 and owned by town. Supply taken from Metropolitan High Service Basin in Middlesex Falls, 6000 to ten million gallons. Water pumped from Spot Pond located two miles S.W. of Central St. by one Holly Engine expansion pumping engine capable 20 million gallons per 24 hours and by one Leavitt compound pumping engine, 15,000,000 gallons per 24 hours. Average pressure, 80 lbs. per sq. inch. 25 miles of pipe from 4" to 20" in diam. owned by town. 170 hydrants, fully equipped, 370000 gallons.

FIRE DEPARTMENT
 Volunteer: One chief, two assistants and six callmen. One 24 class Massachusetts steam fire engine. One hook & ladder truck. Three 2-horse hose wagons. One combination wagon with 35 gallon chemical, 7000' of 1" C.R.L. hose in good condition, Gamewell fire alarm system, 28 boxes. Whistle and bell alarm.

Streets macadamized. Street lights, electric.
