
**Discussion of Traffic Pattern Changes Required During the Construction of the New Middle School/Public Hearing**

The Board of Selectmen met at the Central School at 7:00 PM to approve traffic regulation on Pomeworth St. The Board heard from many of the residents and listened to their concerns. The residents were asked to vote for a preference between having Pomeworth a one way 24 hours a day 7 days a week or 7:30 to 3:30 during school times. The residents voted 16 to 6 in favor of the 7:30 to 3:30 option. Selectmen Sweeney made a motion to have Pomeworth a one way between the hours of 7:30 to 3:30 during school times from Williams St. to Washington St. Selectmen Boussy seconded the motion. **Motion was unanimously voted (4-0).**
