| | <i>Review Meeting minutes (May and June). May approved unanimously. June approved with 3 abstentions.</i> |
| | <i>Larry Means – Meeting Minutes, Greenway fund</i> Town Moderator Larry Means spoke briefly. He is visiting committees for which he appoints members and checking on issues such as minutes. Greenway/Bikeway Meeting minutes are up to date so it is not an issue. He also is checking on how monies in the fund from railroad ROW leases have been spent. Mr. Means also brought up the issue of citizens with appointments to more than one committee. The Committee voted 2 in favor to discuss, 1 against with 6 abstentions. Mr. Means argued that the chairman should resign and should not serve on the Board of Selectman and the Greenway Committee. Anthony Wilson said he had consulted with the Town Counsel who did not believe this to be against town bylaws. With two exceptions, members spoke in favor of him remaining to see the project through to construction. |
