All recyclables can be placed in one container marked "Recycling".


Paper

Place in bin

- Newspapers/inserts
- Magazines, catalogs
- Paperboard (cereal, cracker boxes)
- Corrugated cardboard, flatten, 2'x2' only
- Phone books
- Brown paper bags
- Junk mail
- Office paper
- No wax paper, plastic coated paper or plastic bags.

Containers

Place in bin

- Glass bottles/jars, all colors & sizes
- Aluminum/tin/steel cans and lids
- All plastic containers labeled 
- Milk Cartons and juice boxes
- No broken glass or other items (e.g. window glass, dishes, glass, Pyrex, ceramics, light bulbs)
- No cans or bottles containing paint, aerosol or hazardous materials
- No plastic bags
