	<i>Review Meeting minutes - Minutes for March 13 passed unanimously.</i>
	<i>Open Space and Recreation Plan Update – Bill Murphy - Nothing to report as the steering committee has not met since our last meeting. Waiting for report and an additional public hearing.</i>
	<i>Project Status - Tentative Groundbreaking on May 11 early in the morning. Dolly will report when the time and location are definite. Tree work should start in Winchester this week. Dolly reported that the MassDOT Resident engineer said the contractor typically likes to work 10 – 12 hours per day, to finish sooner.</i>
	<i>11 Manison St –Site plan for 11 Manison Street tomorrow at the BOS. Wall is being constructed to allow additional flat space at the Manison Street level. 42 Pleasant St. - construction fencing is over the edge of the RROW. Dolly talked to TA Younger about the issue and Mr. Younger will ensure fence is moved or there is a legal construction easement.</i>
	<i>Outreach Winchester Town Day (June 3) table option – if deadline has not passed. Note Stoneham Town Day is Sept 16 this year. Greenway Cleanup. May 20 9-11:30 am Meet at Pomeworth/Middle School. <i>Greenway Naming - Naming: Cindy suggested that the bikeway be named after Cameron Bain. Officially, the MassDOT name is Tri-Community Bikeway and they are producing and paying for trail signage. Stoneham could perhaps have an additional name in the Stoneham portion. Discussion about what would be required to do this, and if Town Meeting approval could be required. The town does not name schools after individuals. It was also suggested to name the nature park proposed by Cameron, adjacent to Sweetwater Brook, for him. We would likely need to get donations for a sign to name our section for Cameron. Dolly suggested we start the naming process by talking to the Town Administrator to find out if it can be done. Discussion of the name - Cameron Bain Greenway, approved unanimously, with one abstention (Cameron).</i></i>
