Review and discuss the following:

First Topic on Discussion: Heidi Gergostergios started as our Public Health Nurse on January 23, 2024 and is familiarizing herself with MIIS and MAVEN software programs. Also, she has completed some webinars and emergency preparedness. - PHN completed educational webinars in Mpox, TB, tick-borne diseases, emergency preparedness,
- Administered five doses of flu vaccine in the PHN office.
- **Stoneham Confirmed MAVEN** cases from 1/1/24-2/14/24:
  - Hepatitis C 1
  - Monkey Pox: 1
  - Tuberculosis 1; TB case now residing outside of Stoneham during treatment.
  - Influenza: 107; LBOH no longer interviews cases.
  - COVID: 86 (PCR); The number of cases is most likely higher due to community home testing. LBOH no longer interviews cases.
- **Stoneham Probable MAVEN** cases from 1/1/24-2/14/24:
  - Legionellosis
- PHN had an initial meeting with the Nurse Leader, Katie Lavery of Stoneham, MA
