Agenda Item 3: Formation of High School Building Committee/Appoint Members of the BOS/SC/FAB to the High School Building Committee Meredith-Warren requested that the Board of Selectmen appoint a School Building Committee to work with the Town and State in supervising the process of a new high school, in parallel, but not contingent upon being accepted into the MSBA pipeline. The School Building Committee would be made up of the following:

- three voting members – one each from the School Committee, Board of Selectmen, and Finance and Advisory Board
- non-voting members – Town Administrator, Superintendent, Director of School Finance, High School Principal, and Director of School Facilities
- Other members (community, etc.) to be appointed by Select Board at a later date.

The School Committee appointed Nicole Niall to serve on the School Building Committee.

The Board of Selectmen appointed Raymie Parker to serve on the School Building Committee.

The Finance and Advisory Board appointed Susan Lippman to serve on the School Building Committee.

Wilson moved to appoint the above voting and non-voting members to the School Building Committee. Seibold seconded the motion. Voted unanimously.


