

What is an outpatient program?

An outpatient program is a non-residential program. This means that a person does not live at the program. They attend the program as long and as many times they want.

SOAP program- intensive outpatient program of substance use disorder

IOP Program- intensive outpatient program for outpatient services

Day Program/Clubhouse model- work program for individuals with mental illness
