MINUTES – FEBRUARY 13, 2017

Present: T. Barry, Chair; D. Manchester (until 5:00 pm), L. Olson, D. Piatt, T. Waitkevitch, A. Wilson, T. Younger

T. Barry called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm.

The committee reviewed the report and article that was submitted to the Selectmen after the conclusion of the last meeting. L. Olson reported that an engineer will be coming in to inspect and provide a recommendation on the Robin Hood sprinkler system; also, initial reports are that one of the two boilers at the Old Central School will need to be replaced.

The committee revised the 5-year plan based upon the funding recommending for the May meeting. A “2018 A” column will be added for the two items – the High School and police vehicles – that may be considered in the fall. Other 2018 items were moved to 2019 or beyond with a goal of smoothing out the financial impact. Specific replacement charts will be developed for DPW equipment and police vehicles. A “Policy Determination Needed” category will be developed for issues such as Complete Streets, Green Communities, and the fire substation.

The meeting adjourned at 6:13 pm. The next meeting will be February 28 at 4 pm.
