Street Sweeping is an essential activity that occurs every spring in the Town of Stoneham. Sand and Salt that is put down during the winter months, has to be picked up in the spring.

Street Sweeping reduces the risk of flooding by removing material before it enters the drainage system. Sweeping operations are ideally required prior to performing the Town's Water Flushing Program and yearly maintenance contracts including, but not limited to Pavement Markings and Catch Basin Cleaning.

Residents are encouraged to aid the Department by:

1. Sweeping sand from sidewalks and grass strips into the street 1 foot from edge of roadway.
2. Please do not sweep the sand into piles, sweep sand along the curb. Sweepers cannot pick up brush, branches or yard waste. Please bring these items to the Stevens Street Recycling Center (stickers required, see website for further information).

Sweeping is scheduled to begin Tuesday, May 26, 2020.

- a. Major "Chapter 90" Roads – ongoing
- b. Southwest Quadrant – May 26 through June 5
- c. Northwest Quadrant – June 8 through June 19
- d. Northeast Quadrant – June 22 through July 3
- e. Southwest Quadrant – July 6 through July 17

Please note, weather and emergencies extend the estimated completion dates of each quadrant.
