Phase II of the MA re-opening plan is slated to begin on Monday, June 8th. As nicer weather and current events may shift focus, we ask that residents still understand that there is a currently still an active pandemic in the Commonwealth. As Public Health metrics continue to trend in the right direction, it is hopeful that the re-opening continues on as scheduled, but vigilance on behalf of all residents of the Commonwealth is still required. Stoneham reached several positive milestones this past week, achieving 0 new positive case reports two days in a row, marking the first instances of no new cases since March 2020.
