A Stoneham Resident returned from Uganda. (outbreak of Ebola in Uganda 11/7/22) The CDC is asking State Health Departments to f/u with travelers returning from Uganda to assess their risk of exposure.

There have been no suspect or confirmed EVD cases related to this outbreak that have been reported in the United States.

- (1) Conduct risk assessment with traveler via phone or text twice a week.
- (2) Classify the risk based on CDC's Risk Assessment Table.
- (3) Ask if traveler has any symptoms.
- (4) Verify last date in affected country
