

**Stoneham Board of Selectmen – Minutes of Meeting of October 15, 2012**

**Approve Site Plan Decision Letter/185 Main Street**

Selectman Richard S. Gregorio moved approval of the site plan decision letter for 185 Main Street. Motion was seconded, and a roll call was taken.

**Miscellaneous Correspondence**

Selectman Sweeney asked what is happening with recycling. Selectman Boussy suggested possibly using Facebook as a resource to inform residents of recycling and selectmen meeting information. Selectman Sweeney suggested aiming focus on the schools/children to educate parents on this issue.

Selectman DePinto asked if any decisions have been made on Ravine Road. Town Administrator Ragucci said he has not heard anything. Selectmen DePinto said he has received all positive feedback from Stoneham Residents and that it should stay the way it is. Selectman DePinto suggested that Stoneham put a permanent barrier. Town Administrator Ragucci said that it can not be done because Ravine Road is also part of Melrose. Selectman Sweeney said that the final decision will be made by Commissioner Lambert not by either town. Town Counsel suggested another traffic study and Selectman Sweeney stated another traffic study being a waste of money. Selectman DePinto requested that Ravine Road discussion be put on the agenda for October 23, 2012.

Motion was made and seconded to go into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing the Stoneham Patrolmen's grievance. A roll call vote was taken.
